As a consultant, I worked to refine the mission, policies, and procedures of the YYC, a community-based clinic associated with the USF Department of Pediatrics that provides sexual health services to youth aged 13 to 24, to improve clinic function and establish a sustainable model of operations. Since being appointed the clinic's Executive Director, I have continued to work to create a clinic that meets the myriad needs of the vulnerable, high-risk youth it serves. I have facilitated collaborations with other community agencies to address non-medical needs and have been instrumental in obtaining multi-year federal funding to support clinic operations and research activities. The outreach efforts I oversee have led to regional and national recognition of the YYC as a leader in providing innovative care that addresses the whole patient. Youth input is consistently obtained through an active Youth Community Advisory Board that vets new initiatives and ensures that the clinic environment is welcoming and inclusive. Achievements to date include:

- 2016: Review of job descriptions, staff self-evaluations, restructuring of payment system, reevaluation of vision and mission.
- 2017: Establishment of clinic database used to track all YYC clinical activities and allow for the assessment of program initiatives.
- 2018: Establishment of YYC internship program for USF students to enhance educational opportunities while providing additional labor to accomplish unfunded clinic projects.
- 2019: Development of partnership with Healthy Start Coalition to fund part-time Adolescent Health Navigator to facilitate referrals to community agencies.
- 2019: Creation of a formal Memorandum of Understanding for YYC community partners to meet patient needs not provided for at the YYC with 14 MOU's in place to date
- 2019: Creation of a system for incorporating assessment of social determinants of health and their impact on needed services into routine clinic screening forms
- 2020-22: Oversight of YYC during COVID-19 pandemic with resultant continued provision of clinical services, no loss of grant funding due to unmet deliverables, and no evidence of COVID-19 transmission to patients or staff

I have directed multiple year-long projects funded by the Ryan White program, as detailed in Sponsored Research, that led to new approaches to care transition, utilization of telehealth, rapid initiation of antiretroviral therapy, and intimate partner violence screening for our HIV program.
